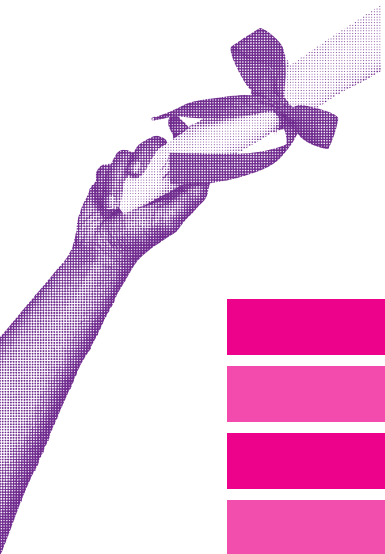

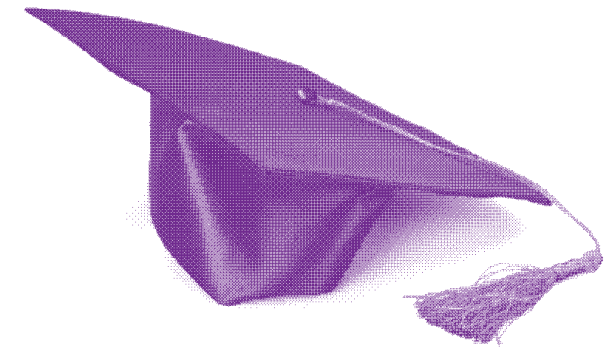

LIVING COSTS

Accommodation ≈ 200-600 EUR per month (Depending on the chosen solution, shared flat/Crous accommodation/private flat etc.).

Food ≈ 150 EUR per month (Crous canteen offers a 10 pts meal system for 1.00 EUR; each dish is worth a specific amount of pts., use them to compose your lunch).

Transportation ≈ 25 EUR for students monthly pass (includes all LE MET' services, check LE MET' Espace Mobilité in Place de la République and get your monthly pass).

Extra expenses ≈ 150 EUR per month, depending on student life.

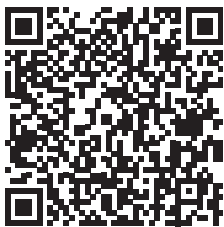
